The **Advanced driver assistance system (ADAS) training** is an up-skilling course for currently licensed automotive technicians and senior level apprentices to master their understanding of ADAS as well as develop recalibration and repair skills relating to ADAS.

The **Electric Vehicle (EV) Up-skilling training** is an up-skilling course allowing current licensed automotive technicians and senior level apprentices to develop maintenance and repair skills relating to EVs.

Advanced driver assistance system (ADAS) training

This training is for current licensed automotive technicians and senior level apprentices employees looking to up-skill and expand their understanding and improve their recalibration skills of ADAS.

This training consists of 16 hours of in-person theoretical and hands-on training led by College instructors.

EV up-skilling training

This training is for current licensed automotive technicians and senior level apprentices employees looking to up-skill their EV competencies.

This training consists of in-person theoretical and hands-on training led by College instructors for 2-3 days a week.

Topics will include:

- Safety
- State of the art tools and use
- Diagnostic trouble codes
- Electric motor controls
- High voltage battery introduction
- Autonomous driver assistance systems (ADAS)

- 18 years of age or older;
- a Canadian citizen, Permanent resident or awaiting Permanent resident status:
- currently employed in Ontario as a licensed automotive technician or senior level apprentice;
- a resident of Ontario.
