- a resident of Ontario.

Complete the mandatory EV Safety module and choose from specialized modules including:

- Motors and controls
- HVAC and battery thermal management
- Electric braking and driver assists
- Low voltage and network communication
- High voltage charging and control
- Drivetrain and gear reduction
- High voltage batteries

Flexible, module-based training — build the skills you need, at your pace.
