








Take charge of your career through free Innovation in Automotive Training

The Electric Vehicle (EV) Up-skilling training allows current licensed automotive technicians and senior level apprentices to further develop maintenance and repair skills relating to EVs.

Career Exploration training

This training is for job seekers looking to work in the automotive trades.

- unemployed or underemployed;
- interested in a career in automotive trades;
- a resident of Ontario.

EV Up-skilling training

This training is for current licensed automotive technicians and senior level apprentices employees looking to up-skill their EV competencies.

Training format: in-person theoretical and hands-on training led by College instructors for 2-3 days a week.

Eligibility:

- 18 years of age or older;
- a Canadian citizen, Permanent resident or awaiting Permanent resident status;
- currently employed as a licensed automotive technician or senior level apprentice;
- a resident of Ontario.
